

REGULATION AND SCHEDULING SHC - ARAXÁ 2017 ELITE AND SUB23 ONLY

This regulation can change up to the date of publication printed before the race. If in doubt, the prevailing print edition and available in the office before the steps of the event and the decisions of the Technical Meeting held the day before the start of the race

### 1. CALENDAR

• 1» Etapa: March 3th thru 5th – Araxá – MG

## 2. RACE SHC CATEGORIES SUPER ELITE MALE AND FEMALE (ELITE + U23)

The SHC race will be run in three days of competition, and the Final General Classification champion will be the rider with the lowest cumulative time in the 3-day stage race.

• Important: the athlete who does not complete the first or second day of the competition (whatever the reason) will be disqualified and can no longer compete in the following days.

### Day 1 / Friday: XCT format (Time Trial)

- The starting order will respect the updated UCI ranking. ie the athlete with the highest score in the ranking will start first.
- Riders will start individually, every minute. The best 10 ranked riders (Man and Women), that will start first, will have a gap of 2 minutes
- Elite Women will start first. Five minutes after the last rider arrives, Elite Man will start competing.
- Technical Area, the same place for all 3 days of competition, will be open and only team personal with bracelet ID will be able to enter in this area.
- Awards Ceremony will start right after results been published and the top 10 riders of each category must present themselves for the podium.

### Day 2 / Saturday: XCC format (Short Track)

- The final time of the Friday's Time Trial race (XCT) will define the starting order for this event, XCC format.
- For the Elite Categories, Men and Women, there will be only one heat of competition: A Final for Men and a Final for Women.
- Both races will run during 25 minutes, plus 2 laps on a course of approximately 2km.
- On both races there will be an elimination criteria, such as the 80% cut at the XCO races. The back markers (overlapped riders) will be removed from the race course and will receive the same time from the last rider on the course, plus 30 seconds penalty per position in this race.
- Feed and Tec Zones will be open, in the same place for every day. Only
  personal with credentials (specific wrist bands) will be permitted to enter at this
  area.
- Immediately after the results, podium ceremonies will be organized and the top 10 riders must be present for the awards.

#### Day 3 / Sunday: XCO format (Cross Country)

- Riders will compete during 6 to 7 laps on a course with approximately 5.5km in length. The alignment criterion for the last stage will be the Individual General Classification following the Friday and Saturday races.
- There will be a Start Loop only for the men Elite/U23 race. Maybe, if decided at the Tec Meeting, we can organize it for the Women Elite as well.
- Awards Cerimony will be organized immediately after results been posted and the top 10 riders must be present at the podium. Right after, there will be the Awards for the General Classification as well.

From 8:30 am - early evidence qualifiers Short Track Super Elite Men From 9.30: Final Short Track (XCC) Super Elite Women and Men - (times may be altered by the live) and then Award Cerimonies

10:00 to 15 hours: free training XCO (prohibited without numeral train and safety equipment) - Short Track (XCC) will be unavailable for training during the competition.

18h15: Start of the Technical Meeting with athletes and teams
