

*This Regulation may change until the date of the printed publication before the test. In case of doubt, the printed and available edition at the secretariat prevails before the stages races and the decisions of the Technical Congress*

**1. CALENDAR**

- 1» Stage Race: march, 5th to 8th – Araxá – MG

**2. ANTI-DOPING EXAM**

- We will have anti-doping exam for athletes, in any CIMTB stages.

**3. SHC PROOF - SUPER ELITE (ELITE + SUB23) MALE AND FEMALE**

- The SHC proof will be played in 4 days of competition, and the final classification will be through the sum of the times, of each athlete, in the 4 days of event. The athlete with the lowest accumulated time in the 4 (four) days of the competition will be champion.
- Important: the athlete who does not complete the first, second or third day of the competition (for whatever reason) will be disqualified and will not be able to continue in the competition for the following days.

**3.1 - Day 1 / THURSDAY (03/05) - 14h00: XCT format (TIME TRAIL)**

- The starting order will respect the updated UCI ranking
- The Female's Super Elite starts first. We will have an interval of up to 15 minutes between the last athlete to start and the Male's Super Elite of XCT start.
- The interval between the starts of the athletes in the Male's and Females's Super Elite will be 30 seconds but among the top 10 in the ranking (first to start) the interval will be 1 minute.
- The support area will be functioning and will be in the same place every race day. Only accredited supporters with bracelet identification may enter in the area.
- The prize pool will be at 17h00 and the top 10 in each category must climb on the podium.

**3.2 - Day 2 / FRIDAY (03/06) 13h00 Female / 14h00 Male: XCC format (SHORT TRACK)**

- The starting order will respect the XCM race result in the day before.
- The batteries will have 20 minutes plus 2 laps on a track with a distance between 1 and 2 km..
- We will have START LOOP at XCO starts
- The Male's and Female's Super Elite categories will have only the final battery.
- In all XCC batteries will be used the 50% or 60% elimination criteria at the discretion of the UCI commissioner
- The time of the eliminated athletes will be equal to the time of the last athlete on the same lap as the leader plus 30 seconds of penalty for position.
- The support area will be functioning and on the rise of the pavement, below the support area of all other events. Only accredited supporters with bracelet identification may enter in the area.
- The prize pool will be 4:00 pm and the top 10 finishers in each category must climb the podium.

## 3.3 - Day 3 / SATURDAY (03/07) - 10h00: XCM format (MARATHON)

- The starting order will be the sum of the results of the XCT and XCC races
- Male's Super Elite starts first than Female's Super Elite
- The total of the route will be at least 60 km and will have 3 laps with about 20 km
- The support area will be functioning and will be in the same place every race day. Only accredited supporters with bracelet identification may enter the support area.
- The prize pool will be 3 pm and the top 10 in each category must climb the podium.

## 3.4 - Day 4 / SUNDAY (03/08) - 14h00: XCO format (OLYMPIC CROSS COUNTRY)

- The starting order will be the sum of the results of the XCT, XCC and XCM proofs
- Number of laps: will be defined after we know the time of the champion of the XCT race on Thursday (should vary from 6 to 7 laps for men and 4 to 5 laps for women).
- We will have **START LOOP** only for the Men's Super Elite categories and, perhaps (to be defined at the Technical Congress), for the Women's Super Elite.
- The support area will be functioning and will be in the same place every race day. Only registered supporters with bracelet identification may enter the support area..
- The prize will be 16h15 and the top 10 in each category must climb on the podium. After the stage award, the accumulated general award will be made.

## 4. LEADER SHIRT / CAP TO CHAMPIONS

- Athletes who go up on the podium are obligated to wear the leader shirt provided by the organization during the race and on the podium (the athlete must wear the shirt on the podium after everyone has presented) - including the Araxá race phases
- The athlete may apply up to 3 logos of his sponsors ONLY in the blank space available on the front and back of the shirt. If the athlete applies any visual identity that interferes with the logos of the event sponsors, the organization will not allow the shirt to be used in the event. The leading athlete who is not wearing the leader shirt in the event and / or in the podium award will be disqualified.
- The top 10 finishers of all categories will receive an event cap to be worn on the podium (with the flap facing forward), mandatorily, at the time of the official photo. After the official photo and with the organizer's authorization, cyclists will have a moment to take pictures with the cap with their sponsors.

## 5. STAGE WINNERS IN THE MALE AND FEMALE SUPER ELITE

- The athletes who are the champions of the stage and the leader of the championship must give their interviews, mandatorily, in front of the event panel installed near the finish line or in the award panel. Failure to comply with this item may result in a warning or a fine, according to the UCI commissioner present at the event.

- **08h00 to 18h00:** confirmation of registration and accreditation of support athletes / teams
- **11h00:** Beginning of the Technical Congress with athletes (Super Male's and Female's Elite) and teams
- **14h00: XCT START - Super Female's and Male's Elite**
- **17h00:** Premiação - CIMTB Michelin - XCT - Super female's and Male's Elite

## FRIDAY:

- **10h00 to 17h00:** free XCO and XCM training
- **13h00: 1ª START - CIMTB Michelin** - XCC (SHORT TRACK) - Super Female's Elite
- **14h00: 2ª START - CIMTB Michelin** - XCC (SHORT TRACK) - Super Male's Elite
- **16h00:** Awards - CIMTB Michelin - XCC - Super Female's and Male's Elite

## SATURDAY:

- **10h00: Marathon START** - Super Male's and Female's Elite
- **14h00 to 17h00:** free XCO training
- **17h45:** Awards - CIMTB Michelin - XCM Super Elite

## SUNDAY:

- **14h00: 5ª XCO START - CIMTB Michelin** - SUPER Male's and Female's ELITE
- **16h15:** General awards per stage and general SHC awards in sequence

## 7. 2020 AWARDS

- Medallions for the first 10 of the accumulated SHC and the first 5 of each stage;
- **#1 - ARAXÁ - SUPER MALE/FEMALE ELITE (total R\$ 40.000,00 in cash):**  
**Each day:** medal to the first 10 and 1st place: R \$ 500.00; 2nd place: R \$ 400.00; 3rd place: R \$ 300.00; 4th place: R \$ 250.00; 5th place: R \$ 200.00, 6th place: R \$ 180.00, 7th place: 160.00; 8th place: 140.00; 9th place: 120.00 and 10th place: R \$ 100.00. **General champions** (lowest accumulated time in the 4 days): 1st place: R \$ 2,800.00; 2nd place: R \$ 2,300.00; 3rd place: R \$ 1,800.00; 4th place: R \$ 1,400.00; 5th place: R \$ 1,200.00; 6th place: R \$ 900.00; 7th place: R \$ 700.00; 8th place: R \$ 600.00; 9th place: R \$ 450.00; 10th place: R \$ 300.00

## 8. AWARDS - GENERAL INFORMATION

- **IMPORTANT 1:** To climb to the podium, the athlete must be in team uniform.
- **IMPORTANT 2:** The champion athlete can take his bike to the podium for exhibition and place it on the support that is on the side of the podium;
- **IMPORTANT 3:** The athlete who is not on the podium at the time of the award will lose the prize (product / money and medal), but will not lose the points acquired;
