


1 - Locations:

-  Petrópolis, RJ and Taubaté, SP



2 - Modality:

-  XCC - *mountain bike / SHORT TRACK*


3 - Who can participate:

-  Only athletes registered in the **CIMTB Michelin (Michelin MTB International Cup)** in the Super Elite and Junior categories (Men and Women) can compete in two categories (Men and Women)


4 - Schedule:

-  **Friday:**
 - 10h00 to 14h00:** free XCC training
 - 17h30:** Super Male's and Female's Elite Technical Congress
-  **Sunday:**
 - 14h15:** Female XCC start (Super Elite + Junior together)
 - 15h15:** Male XCC start (Super Elite + Júnior together)
 - 16h00:** XCC Awards

5 - Registration:

-  All male and female Super Elite athletes who register for XCO will automatically be registered for XCC. Athletes in Junior category must request registration separately by email info@cimtb.com.br

6- Stage races awards:

-  Medallions to the top 5 in the Men's and Women's categories and a cash prize distributed as follows to the top 5: **Men's and Women's:** 1st place: R\$ 400.00, 2nd place: R\$ 300.00; 3rd place: R\$ 200.00; 4th place: R\$ 100.00; 5th place: R\$ 50.00

7 - General Competition Rules:

- the alignment criterion will be the UCI ranking with Super Elite ahead of Júnior;
- the athlete who is not present at the start will be disqualified;
- food and/or mechanical support will be allowed in the race only in the support area
- the athlete's XCC score in the overall result will be added to his category, registered in the Michelin CIMTB
- lagging athletes will be withdrawn using the 50% or 60% criterion
- battery time is 20 minutes plus 2 laps
- the athlete must run with the same numeral and chip used in the XCO race

8 - Resources:

- resources will be accepted only at the end of each battery, and must be made to the UCI / CBC Commissioner or technical responsible for the event;

9 - Responsibilities and Obligations:

- the organization, hotels, city halls, UCI, CBC, state federations, press, promoters and sponsors **are not responsible** for any kind of thefts and damage to equipment and / or bicycles or for any trauma and / or injuries to athletes and assistants caused by accidents during training or competition;

10 - It is the responsibility of each participant:

- Comply with the regulations of the event, ensure the *mountain bike's* good image and the preservation of nature, not throwing garbage on the route.
- Follow the rules of the regulation
- Have medical insurance..

11 - Important:

- Omitted cases will be judged by the Race Director and responsible commissioners..
- The organization of the event reserves the right to change the date and place of the proofs, as well as to change any other clause and/or conditions of the present regulation at the technical congress or 2 (two) hours before the start, *being adjusted that all disclosure of any changes will be made through the event's official website www.cimtb.com.br and at the event's secretariat on proof days*
- To resolve any doubts arising from this regulation, the jurisdiction of the district of Belo Horizonte, MG, is hereby elected.
